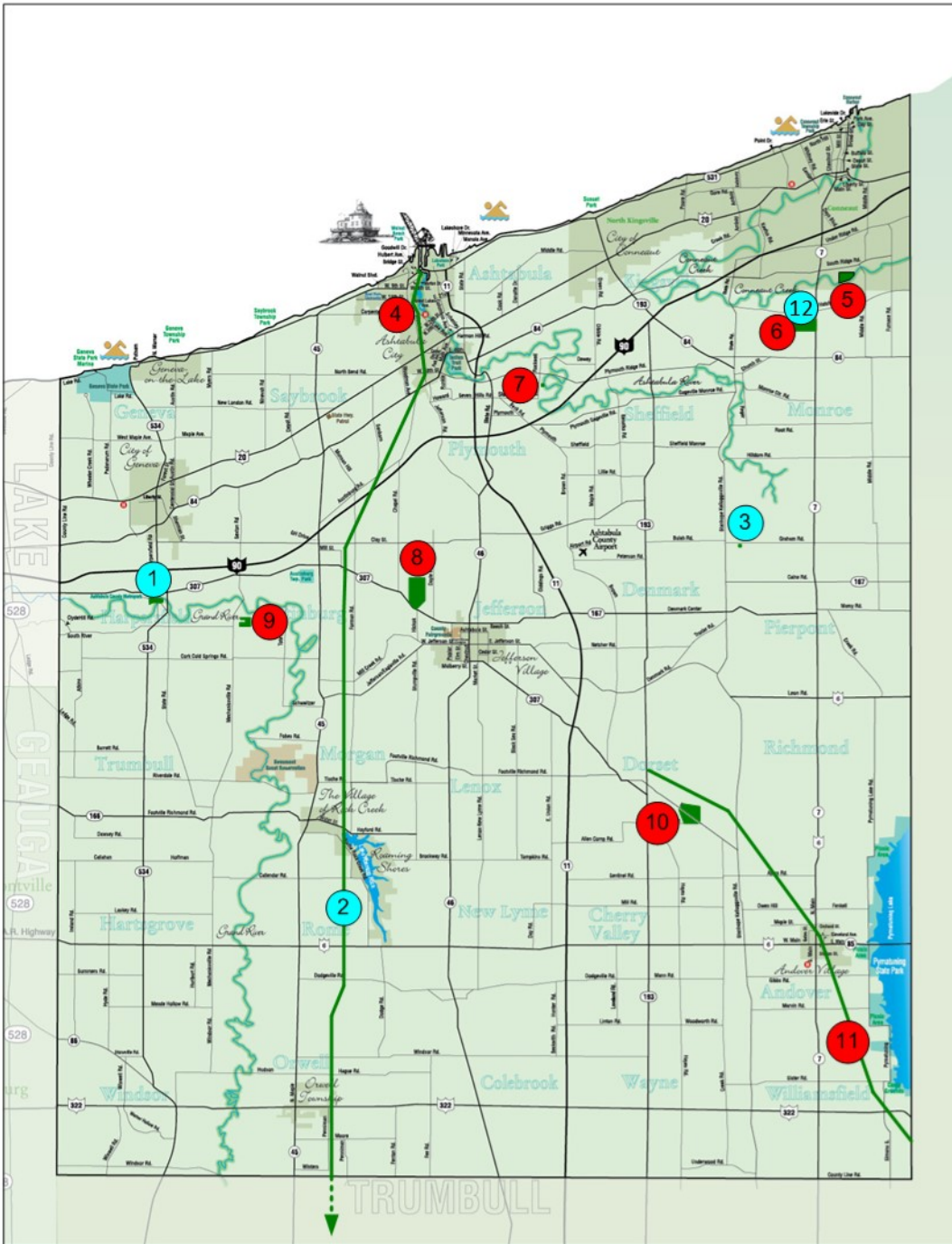


Parks, Trails and Preserves

Ashtabula County Metroparks features 1,050 acres of developed and undeveloped parkland. Take advantage of groomed trails, natural paths and more for your recreational enjoyment.



1-Harpersfield Covered Bridge Metropark: Harpersfield Twp fishing, kayaking, picnicking, photography, and more.

2-Western Reserve Greenway Trail— 27 miles, Ashtabula to southern county line, bicycling, cross-country skiing, horseback riding, running, snowmobiling and more.

3-Graham Road: Pierpont Twp Scenic view of the creek and covered bridge.

4-North Shore Trail: Ashtabula Will connect Lake Erie with the Western Reserve Greenway Trail.

5-Conneaut Creek: Blakeslee Rd 80 acres, fishing, hiking, and scenic views.

6-Hatches Corner: Conneaut 202 acres, hunting, hiking and more.

7-Battles Road: Plymouth Twp 5 acres of undeveloped land with a pond.

8-Lampson Reservoir: Jefferson - 160 acres, hiking, fishing, hunting and more.

9-Eyring Wetlands: Austinburg -Mechanicsville Rd.— 28 acres of undeveloped land, photography, wildlife viewing and more.

10-The Grand Lakes: Dorset 60 acres of undeveloped land with two ponds.

11-Pymatuning Valley Greenway: Dorset Twp—19.5 miles for future development, linking Dorset to the Pennsylvania state line.

12-Clara D. Peet Preserve: Conneaut-Creek Rd.
